

Library Specialist for Technology Job Description

The Position

Under the direction of the department supervisor, the Library Specialist (LS) for Technology will play a key role in implementing and delivering customer-focused technology programs and services. This position will help foster a creative, safe, and fun environment for learning in the Makerspace and learning spaces. This is a paraprofessional position.

Principle Responsibilities

- Assist patrons with basic to advanced questions regarding Makerspace hardware, software, equipment, devices, and research needs
- Assist patrons with the use of computers, visual, audio, and interactive resources, including editing, production, and creation of digital content
- Conduct maintenance, troubleshooting, and inventory control and assist with managing special equipment and collections
- Help plan library activities and services that highlight the Makerspace and digital labs and emphasize information and digital literacy
- Support Librarians in the selection and acquisition of special collections materials
- Collect and track program data, distribute surveys, conduct observations
- Staff service desk in select departments
- Assist with program and supplies purchases
- Assist with outreach and user engagement and work on special projects and initiatives
- Assist with volunteer management, direct and supervise volunteers as needed

- Experience with audio and video recording and editing, coding, 3D modeling, equipment, and fabrication tools
- Understanding of different learning styles, effective teaching principles, and data tracking
- Passion and knowledge about the use of technologies to support creative, engaged learning
- Excellent and effective communication skills with people from diverse backgrounds
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals;
- Understand and carry out complex oral and written instructions
- Work irregular hours, including evenings and weekends
- Lift up to 50 pounds, push loaded book carts, shift furniture
